Meeting Purpose

Original planning advisory team members from the Dignowity Hill Neighborhood Plan and the current registered neighborhood association boards representing neighborhoods within the respective plan areas were invited to join in a discussion of the respective plans and the ongoing creation of the SA Tomorrow Eastside Area Community Plan and Downtown Regional Center Plan. Participants were invited by mail and email or telephone when available. In addition to the formal invitees, additional residents and stakeholders participated in the discussion.

Dignowity Hill Neighborhood Plan Discussion Overview

Approximately twelve people attended the meeting regarding the Dignowity Hill Neighborhood Plan. City staff began the meetings with a brief presentation about the SA Tomorrow Comprehensive Plan and the Sub-Area Plans. Participants then discussed three topics including: important accomplishments from the prior plans, outstanding priorities that have not yet been implemented, and additional recommendations that were not addressed in the prior plans.
